Over the past year and a half there have been many changes at The Road Home and in our community regarding homeless services.

In partnership with Salt Lake County we launched the Pay for Success -Housing Not Jail Pilot Program. This program helps single individuals who are persistently homeless stabilize in housing.

Implementation of a Trauma Informed Care approach.


We transformed crisis service delivery to include Shelter Diversion. This program helps people experiencing homelessness to find alternatives to entering into shelter.

At the conclusion of FY17 Operation Rio Grande improved public safety by reducing crime and created a safer community, while also increasing access to treatment for substance use disorders.

On any given night, we serve approximately 1,600 people with supportive housing services compared to 1,200 in shelter.



Because of your support, in FY 17 we helped 10,853 people overcome homelessness through shelter, case management, and housing.

In the coming year, our goals are to:

- Provide Trauma Informed services throughout the agency.
- Partner with Shelter the Homeless and Cowboy Partners in the development of the Magnolia - a new housing location for people experiencing chronic homelessness.
- Help our community transform our homeless resource center service delivery systems.
