

The Road Home COVID Statement - April 13, 2020

With the first positive COVID-19 cases at the Men's Resource Center (MRC), today and Tuesday, The Road Home, with Utah Department of Health, Salt Lake County Health Department, 4th Street Clinic, the University of Utah Health Care and Intermountain Health Care, will perform a complete testing of all guest at MRC and the Midvale Family Resource Center. Multiple testing stations are set up, with most guests pre-registered so the process can move in a streamlined method. We expect the tests results to come back in an expedited manner, and anyone who tests positive will be transported by the Health Department to medical care or a County isolation facility to recover. Michelle Flynn, Executive Director for The Road Home adds: "In addition to getting those who are sick the care that they need, the information we glean from this will be invaluable data and help us to determine the next steps in preventing the spread of this virus". The Road Home will continue to be diligent in its prevention measures by adding new precautions every week, and continuing to work closely with homeless service providers, the State, County and cities.



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
