THE ROAD HOME

The mission of The Road Home is to help people step out of homelessness and back into our community.

History

Originally established in 1923 to assist stranded travelers, The Road Home has grown to address a spectrum of needs encountered by people experiencing homelessness, including emergency assistance, shelter, case management and housing services.

Emergency shelter and supportive services are provided at our 24/7 resource centers; the Men's Resource Center, the Gail Miller Resource Center, and the Midvale Family Center, to help meet the needs of people in our community. In addition, The Road Home has developed a comprehensive housing program with case managers focused on helping people find, obtain, and remain stably housed.

The Road Home continues to find new innovative housing solutions for people experiencing homelessness. We operate three resource centers and two permanent supportive housing facilities. We also operate the Vulnerable Populations motel which provides emergency shelter for older adults and people with significant health conditions in a non-congregate setting.

Highlights July 1, 2020—April 30, 2021

- A full **2,407 people** have been supported to move into or remain stable in housing.
- All total, they **have been provided nearly 450,000 nights** of housing.
- We are grateful to have provided **147% more housing nights** than shelter nights through April 2021.
- A full 182,197 nights of safe housing-focused emergency shelter were provided to 3,795 men, women, and families with children.

Coming soon:

The Road Home is a partner in developing a new 65-unit permanent supportive housing program, the Magnolia, set to open in Salt Lake City in the summer 2021. This will be our third low-income housing tax credit project that we will operate to serve some of the most vulnerable people in our community who have spent an extended period of time homeless and who also have a disabling condition.
